### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The CISL Student Residence Program offers a complete and rigorous academic program consisting of grammar, comprehension, expression, vocabulary building, and fluency development. The program features a two, three, or four-week CISL English Language Training Course, daily afternoon activities, weekend excursions and optional trip.

- Students are placed in a Standard Program class at our downtown location
- 8 students maximum per class
