PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The English for Academic Purposes (EAP) program at CISL San Diego gives non-native speakers of English the reading, writing, and research skills necessary to succeed in a college or university in the United States.

THE EAP COURSE CAN BE INCLUDED AS PART OF THE FOLLOWING PROGRAMS:

Pre-University Program: *(Designed for gap-year students)*

The EAP Afternoon Elective has been added to effectively prepare students for an academic year abroad.

Pathway Program: *(Designed for academically focused students)*

Successful completion of the EAP course allows students to be conditionally accepted into several colleges or universities in the United States.

Afternoon Elective: The course is also available to all other students as an afternoon option.

For example:

A. Standard English (morning) + EAP (afternoon)

B. TOEFL Preparation (morning) + EAP (afternoon)

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS & SCHEDULE:

English Level Requirement to participate in course:

Upper intermediate (CEFR: B2) or above

Course Duration:

The course is 12 weeks and is divided into four three-week units; students can take one, two, three, or four units of the course.

- Compare and contrast 1 essay
- Problem-solution essay
- Cause and effect essay
- Summary-response essay
- Argumentative essay
