

### 2019 STANDARD ENGLISH PROGRAM



#### COURSE DESCRIPTION

The goal of the Standard Course is to help students use English with accuracy and confidence. The two sessions of the Standard Course are Confidence and Accuracy.

## CONFIDENCE 9:00am-10:40am

This session is designed to help students become more confident and capable communicators.

Confidence Goals: (1) To help students use English with increasing fluency and confidence. (2) To help students use English in a way that is appropriate to a situation and conveys the intended meaning. (3) To encourage students to reflect on and engage with their learning and become autonomous language learners who can recognize and achieve their personal language goals. (4) To increase students' cultural awareness and ability to communicate and connect with people from other cultures.

In class, students will spend time discussing a variety of cultural topics, learning how to use English appropriately in different situations, and learning the common expressions for doing different tasks in English. Lessons will also cover general listening, speaking, reading, and writing with a focus on improving fluency.

# ACCURACY 11:00am-12:40pm

This session is designed to help students improve their control and accuracy in English grammar, speaking, pronunciation, writing, reading, listening, and vocabulary.

#### STUDENT PORTFOLIOS

Student portfolios include four projects:

- cultural project
- writing paper
- speaking presentation
- independent project

Students create portfolios to help them learn new ways to express themselves and give them the opportunity to apply their English skills and knowledge.
