### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The program features a two, three, or four-week CISL English Language + academic course, daily afternoon activities + one full day excursion per week, and room and board.

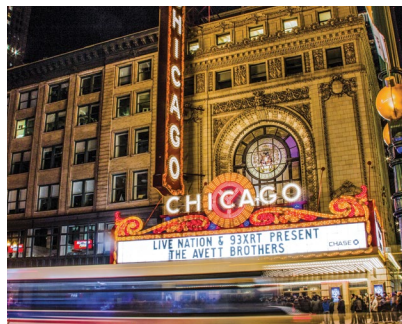
