PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The CISL USD Campus Program offers a complete and rigorous academic program that allows students to not only improve their language and critical thinking skills, but to expand their cultural horizons as well. The program features one to six week CISL English language or specialized two-week courses in Business or Academic English, daily afternoon activities, one full day excursion per week, and room and board.
